### **About the LET Program**

The Association for New Canadians is seeking an experienced Early Childhood Educator for its new Learning English Together (LET) Program. With funding support from the United Way of Newfoundland and Labrador, and delivered in partnership with the Corner Brook Public Library, this program will provide weekly ESL training for parents, playtime in English for pre-school aged children, as well as a group approach to language learning at the end of each session that will provide 30 minutes of parent-child interaction in an English/mother-tongue playgroup setting.

The LET Program will help ensure pre-school aged newcomers have access to language learning activities that promote social interaction and shared play with other children. The program will also offer a structured educational environment that will facilitate their transition to a formal school setting, and assist in easing separation anxiety by offering a supportive space that focusses on child(ren) and parent interaction.

### **Duties:**

- Develop, organize and implement child-care activities that support and promote the physical, cognitive, emotional and social development of children between the ages of 2 and 4 years
- Lead activities by telling or reading stories, teaching songs, and providing opportunities to express creativity through the media of art, play, music and physical activity in a library setting
- Plan and maintain a learning environment that protects the health, security and well-being of children
- Assess the abilities, interests and needs of children and discuss progress or problems with parents and other staff members

### **Qualifications:**

- Extensive knowledge of early childhood education principles and legislation as well as previous experience working in a licensed child care setting
- Strong communication, planning, organizational and conflict resolution skills
- Ability to build trust and positive relationships with children, families and co-workers
- Certificate or Diploma in Early Childhood Education, Level I or Level II Certification from AECENL, and at least one (1) year experience working as part of the staff to child ratio in a regulated child care setting. Applicants with an ECE Entry level in Preschool & School-Age and relevant experience will also be considered.
- Current first aid/CPR and proof of updated immunizations will be required prior to commencement of employment

### **Conditions of Employment**

- Position is subject to receipt of a satisfactory Certificate of Conduct and Vulnerable Sector Check from the Royal Newfoundland Constabulary.
- Applicants must be legally entitled to work in Canada.
